Portico Hole Repairs

A contractor is working to repair a hole in the portico (entrance covering) at the Chico Masonic Family Center. The repair entails installing plywood and stuccoing over the hole to prevent insect intrusion and improve the appearance.

The CMCF has executed additional contracts with Crown Castle and other communication companies to expand operations. This will bring in much needed additional revenue for the CMFC and allow us to perform more maintenance on the facility and grounds. This will better position us financially to take care of these necessary repairs without tapping into our investment funds.

As mentioned last month, we have executed a contract to reseal the parking areas and repaint parking stripes, with this work occurring this fall. During the reseal, the parking lot and CMFC will not be available as the reseal needs time to dry. We will alert appendant bodies when this is scheduled.

What do you do for your community?


I protect and serve my community as a first responder.


What do you do for your local lodge?
