

2024 April Trestleboard Submission from CMFC President

Council Approves Housing Development, Annexing CMFC into the City

In late February the Chico City Council approved a development of 74 homes on 15 acres to the west and north of our Chico Masonic Family Center property. This action overrules the city planning commission's rejection of the proposal in January.

Fortunately, we worked with the developer and the city planning staff to come up with a solution the developer and we could agree upon: a 7-foot stucco wall along our north and west property lines. While not as strong as a block wall we initially requested, we feel this was a fair compromise considering the developer had no obligation to build a block or stucco wall to meet city standards.

The stucco wall will be entirely on the developer's property. This is far better than a standard wooden fence that residents can build gates into and gain easy access to our property to recreate or access their backyards to unload firewood, building materials, etc.

Both the development and our 5-acre property will be annexed into the city of Chico, meaning our police and fire protection will be from the city. The city has zoned our property so we can continue all of our activities at the CMFC as before.

In addition to the stucco wall, the developer will disclose to home buyers the potential for noise from the CMFC. He will also install a 6-inch sewer lateral in the northwest corner of our property for future connections to city sewer should we need to.

The developer has already started to clear his land by cutting down orchard trees, so we can expect construction to start soon.


