



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Chico-Leland Stanford Lodge #111, F.&A.M. is awarding a scholarship grant to graduating high school seniors from Chico and Durham area High Schools who are planning to attend a university, colleges or vocational/technical training school.

The scholarship shall be awarded annually and may be renewed for a period not to exceed four (4) years providing that the recipient remains in good standing at his or her school, college or university and meets all other scholarship conditions.

The award may be used only to defray expenses incident to the student's attendance at a four-year college, university, 2-year college or commercial/trade school.

The recipient must maintain at least a 12 unit per semester load or be certified as a full-time student in a program leading to a degree or certificate. The recipient must maintain a 2.5 grade point average for all courses taken. Recipients must send official transcripts of record to the Chico-Leland Stanford Masonic Scholarship Committee to verify that all requirements for continuation of the scholarship are met. It is the responsibility of the recipient to secure this verification and submit it to the Scholarship Committee in a timely manner, otherwise payment of scholarship funds will be withheld. The scholarship is valid only while the recipient remains in good standing at the school of attendance.

Each scholarship shall be for up to, but not to exceed \$600.00 yearly, payable at \$300.00 per semester or \$200.00 per trimester per student and/or prorated per quarter. The scholarship may be awarded to the recipient on a continuing basis up to four (4) years based on approval of the scholarship committee.

Please make every effort to observe the following concerning your application, so that you are considered as a candidate for receiving our scholarship.

Type or legibly print in ink when filling in the application, answering all questions as completely as possible. Applications **must include** an up-to-date transcript and two letters of recommendation from a family friend, employer, minister, etc. (Do not use family members or school personnel).

The financial page is very important. Financial need is a very important criterion for selection of our scholarship recipients and will be determined from this information. Your application is regarded as confidential and will be seen only by lodge members of the committee. From the information provided each student is placed into one of five financial categories: (1) great need; (2) considerable need; (3) moderate need; (4) some need; (5) little or no need. If no financial information is provided, the applicant will be placed in the, "little or no need" category.
